EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2019-06

AN ORDER CONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL AWARDS COMMITTEE (MAC) FOR THE LUPONG TAGAPAMAYAPA INCENTIVES AWARDS (LTIA)

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 2008-102 dated 17 June 2008 advocates Lupong Tagapamayapa Incentives Awards (LTIA) in community level;


WHEREAS, LTIA aims to: (a) strengthen the Katarungang Pambarangay (KP) Law as an Indigenous Conflict Resolution structure at the grassroots; (b) institutionalize a system of granting benefits and other incentives to Lupong Tagapamayapa, which demonstrate exemplary performance; and (c) generate greater awareness among, and support from, the various sectors of the Philippine Society on the Katarungang Pambarangay (KP) as a potential vehicle toward social ordering and human development;

WHEREAS, the awards committees in the nation, region, provincial, and city/municipal levels shall be organized to perform specific functions to ensure success of the LTIA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **SHARON ROSE G. ESCOTO**, Municipal Mayor, Gubat, Sorsogon, by the power vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Creation of the Municipal Awards Committee (MAC): There is hereby established a Municipal Awards Committee, which shall be composed of the following:

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Section 2. Functions: The MAC shall take the lead in all LTIA-related activities in the municipal level. In doing so, the MAC shall:

- Initiate and coordinate the necessary activities toward the successful implementation of the LTIA in the municipality;
- Disseminate information on the Awards to generate awareness and support from the public and private sectors within the municipality;
- Select and submit to the Provincial Awards Committee, the best performing lupon within the municipality;
- May secure funding and counterpart prizes from the private sector; and
- May plan and implement appropriate awarding ceremonies.

Section 3. Funding requirements: Funds for all LTIA-related activities in the municipality shall emanate from the Office of the Mayor or any available local funds, subject to the usual accounting rules and procedures.

Section 4. Effectivity: This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
