### The EXECUTIVE REPORT

It is another year for all of us, as we welcome 2018 with our MAYAD na GUBAT, MAYAD na GUBATNON Programs, we would like to thank God above all for the previous year 2017 ... for the generally good year (typhoons are inevitable here in Bicol but not as disastrous ... we have managed it through), for the blessings, for our people's cooperation, active participation, along with the help from our top elected officials especially Sen Chiz and Cong. Ding for coordination and connections, we at the LGU Gubat have all these projects, programs and activities approved and implemented, for the good times and for all the opportunities along with the challenges and trials given us ... yes, we also have our bad times but I am so thankful that we still moved as one, we have conquered our Goliaths together, unified, guided by our vision ... the SHARED Governance (Salud – Hanapbuhay – Agrikultura – Rehabilitasyon sa Rekursos Naturales – Edukasyon – Dedikasyon sa Pase Orden, nan MAYAD nan Transparensiya sa Panggogobyerno). Today, for the first session of the SB for the year 2018, we are all here for the Executive and Legislative Report para sa Gubat, para sa lambang Gubatnon.

To start with, we refer to our campaign promise, our vision for our community, that is to be a place of trade and industry, agro & eco tourism, and quality education through SHARED Governance. How far have we gone?

## 3. MLGP Municipal Leadership & Governance Program

Kaintrado tabi kita sini na Programa sa Salud san DOH-Ateneo-Pfizer Foundation para ma-empower an mga LCE nan an Municipal Health Officer san tama nan mayad na pagmanehar san Basic Health Services san 1 na Komunidad. Pag-urupod ta po dini sa programa an mga municipalidad san Prieto Diaz, Bulusan, Irosin, Castilla

nyan Pilar. San nakaagi na panggogobyerno an bongto san Gubat is the only drop-out municipality all over the Philippines sa mga enrolled sa program na ini ... diri na yoon niyan mangyayari, babawion ta po yoon. We will make a difference because in this administration we care a lot for our people, we care enough for our health because we truly believe that health is wealth. We can truly say we are developing when our people are knowledgeable and healthy. The first module of this program is more on the basic management and bridging the gap for health services, the reason why we had our deep dive to two barangays: Bagacay and Rizal primarily to address the root causes of lifestyle related diseases here in Gubat which is alarmingly increasing.

When I talked about deep dive, this is all about immersion to the real world. When I was a Councilor in 2013-2016 that was the thing that I did together with Kons. Kenneth, Kons. Monching and then Kons. JoArt ... we immersed ourselves to feel from the people themselves the real situations in the Barangays. The very reason why in our campaign we have it as part of our priority programs: ambulance and doctor to the barangays, the people's clamor ... the product of our immersion = our campaign promise as discussed well with Vice Mayor Sixto, = our guide in delivering services for our health programs = our implemented and on-going projects. At this juncture, I would like to thank all the members of the SB for embracing this program through legislative support.

Again, MLGP will be adopted here in Gubat and we have proven it already to be an efficient and effective tool of managing health.

#### 4. SADIRING PROGRAMA SA SALUD SA BONGTO SAN GUBAT

#### **DOKTOR SA MGA BARANGAY**

Dahil sa immersion namo (4quanttos) sa mga barangay, tunatak sa isip nan puso ko an priyoridad na proyekto sin ambulansya nan doktor sa mga barangay, hanggan naging campaign promise namo ni VM Sixto dahil sa comporme man siya sa pangangaipo na ini ... nakapalaman ini sa SHARED Governance. Sayo kaadlaw niyan na 2017 pinagahoy ako ni Cong. Ding to present to me what health project he is thinking about and alas just exactly the same as the promised project namo ni VM Sixto, so click. We have our initial move on the availability of the salary of our Doctor hanggan sa paghanap kun sino an pwede ... nakaabot ako po sini sa DOH regional office. Sabi ko sakanira, because we were not included in the DTTB program of DOH we will have it funded locally just to have another doctor because it is the need of our people and we would just like to ask for help in finding a doctor, DOH Region V is happy for this initiative but is negative to finding a doctor. Good that Dra. Marian accepted the challenge. Salamatonon Dra.!

DSMB was implemented in August 2016, although Dra. Marian came in 1 month after August, preparations had been done as we anticipated the increase in medicine consumption and other preparatory works before the barangay visits. With the DSMB, I am so happy with Dra Marian's report of the number of patients being checked per day plus the patients that cannot come, were home visited ... totoong serbisyo po ang ating handog. Kun medyo kaipuhan pa sin iba pa na serbisyo medical, yoon po an saato referral sa iba na mga hospital through the BRTTH/PGH/ other Government Hospitals where Cong. Ding have his fund allocation. Daog sini an mga Medical Missions, na after san Medical Mission tapos na, but we can also have such health mission for special cases.

Barangays visited to date were:		

With the very positive result of the DSMB Program, Cong Ding has provided us in 2017 a vehicle for the Doctor (mao po yadto na Toyota Innova). Niyan na 2018, Cong Ding will have it implemented for the 9 municipalities under the 2<sup>nd</sup> congressional district of Sorsogon which included Gubat ... the reason why we have the Bajaj para sakayan po san sayo pa na doctor para sa mga barangay. Sa kaso san Gubat, we will have 2 doctors sa mga barangays for 2018, meeting the standard RHU Doctor of 1: 20,000 population. We started in 2016 with 1RHU Doctor: 60,000 population (Dr. Tony Lelis lang an ato Doc sini na panahon), this 2017 we have it as 1:30,000

(gusto sabihon si Dr. Lelis assigned sa RHU plus si Dra Marian mao an sa DSMB) and hoping to have a ratio this 2018 of 1:20,000 (with Dr. Lelis, Dra. Marian nan sin sayo pa na doctor ... basi may aram kamo magrikomendar po) which is the standard RHU Doctor to population ratio.

Sayo pa na dagdag na magayon na balita an approval sin 1 na dentista para sa Municipyo san Gubat niyan na 2018 na an masweldo an DOH. Nag-uumapaw pong pasasalamat sa mga grasya na nag-aarabot dini saato. Isn't Gubat that lucky to have all these blessings. I believe dahil yon sa maboboot kita, mahigos nan mayad na Gubatnon! (I would like to take this opportunity, basi may on kamo aram na gusto magserbisyo dini saato for 2018 we needed 1 medical doctor and 1 dentist.)

Another thing to be thankful about is Dr. Joe Quiring on his free time will also go with the DSMB program and he is very active not only in health services but also in the peace and order representing the Parish Pastoral. Salamat po Dr. Joe, indeed an example of a true volunteerism for a true blooded Gubatnon.

Dahil sa DSMB, we were one of the municipalities with the greatest patients checked in the province of Sorsogon & we have received the award this December 2017. To sum up this program: additional doctors = additional health services = preventive medical care = mabaskog na Gubatnon!

5. NUTRITION Program to combat malnutrition:

**GULAYAN SA BAWAT TAHANAN-BARANGAY-PAARALAN.** This project was launched in July 2017 primarily to combat malnutrition. Seeds and technical assistance were free from our Municipal Agriculture Office, an kaipuhan nalang po lugar in which I believe we still have plenty, Ialo na an sa mga rural na barangay nan an pinakaimportante higos, na mao man po kita yoon ... an Gubatnon, mahiguson. Tama? Gardens will not only be gardens, it should support our intention to feed our children with nutritious food that is why in selecting the best implementer of the program we might come to a criteria of 50-50, meaning 50% of how well you have tendered your garden and its sustainability (diri lang niyan na January but year-round) and another 50% on the highest decrease in malnutrition within your respective barangay. I am thankful that this program which we have launched in July was supported by an Ordinance authored by Kons. Anthony Callos.

At this point, nagpapasalamat ako san management nato niyan san MNAO with our BNSs' help because we have now the correct baseline data na mao an ato gagamiton sa mga pagdedesisyon san saato interventions to lessen or eradicate malnutrition among our children. I also would like to commend our MNAO Renz Bino for the interventions that we were able to have the financial aid to our BNSs back, coming from the association which our BNSs haven't received for quite sometime because of unmet compliances ... and now we have complied, that is good management and good governance.

6. INFRASTRUKTURA: RHU Rehabilitation through BDO Foundation (na-aprubaran niyan na 2017, for implementation niyan na 2018 ... during the rehabilitation maybe the LGU Gubat will have to rent again at BLGU-Luna Candol).

Construction of 2/F of the TB-DOTS through DOH (Bidded in 2017, implementation this 2018)

7. IMPLEMENTASYON SAN AYUDA PARA SA COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS.

We salute the BHWs and the BNSs' dedication to their field work regarding health, salamat Kons. Val Pura IV for pushing through with this ordinance and this December 2017 we have tried our best to implement it no matter how tight the budget which was retroactive September 2017. This was also my wish when I was a Konsehal, and, wish granted. This is an incentive that will make our Community Health Workers be inspired more!
