happen/ I monitored it myself with the MDRRM Team of Gubat/ thru the leadership of Rhalen Endeno /let us also think about this Climate Change .. / yes, / seryosohon ta ini/ an pagprotehir san saato palibot /nan pagmanihar san saato basura, /let us all think about this,/ kay an buwelta saato man lang. /This is also a call to plant more trees , /more trees to plant than the cuttings. /

Mariann Pura Ecleo and all the health workers on duty.)**

- **DPWH Isolation Facility – was readied /to serve Biyajeros /and incoming residents of Barangays Bagacay, /Ogao, /Paco,/ Nato/and Patag,/ thanks to DPWH for letting us use the facility and for some divisions done in compliance to the protocols, /salamat Engr. Felix Dimaano,/ our DE for the 2nd /The LGU had the water and electricity reconnected/ and repairs were also done./**
- **Barangay Isolation Units – managed by BHERTs /through the assessment of HRHs./ Facilitation includes Barangay's food provision /through their**

respective relatives /and kabarangay. /This was a big help to decongest our BU QFac, /salamat non sa intero na Kapitan sa pagmanihar./

- **Disinfection**
 - LGU Facilities/affected private residences/Business Entities – c/o MDRRM Team, an sa mga pribado after 1 time demonstration, tinutukduan na po sira to be on their own in the next succeeding disinfection pero kun diri pa rin kaya, pwede pa man another round of tutorial.
 - Market – c/o Market Team as tutored by MDRRM Team

 - **Transportation Scheme** – with the lockdown, /the LGU Gubat provided free rides to our health frontliners /and those working in Sorsogon. / We also provided rides to our Dialysis Patients /enrolled in Sorsogon, /to quote Dr. Chacon, /“Gubat is the only municipality providing free rides/ to the dialysis patients/ ... thank you!”/

 - **Food Preparation** – a kitchen had been established for the preparation of food for the health frontliners as well as the incoming LSIs, PUIs, PUMs

 - **SAP** – as of 11/27/2020, the only municipality with liquidated SAP/ & complete list of paid beneficiaries of 9,940 households/ covering the 42 barangays of Gubat/ – DONE/ (as shown in the table ...) ... I would like to congratulate the MSWD staff na tunutok dini sa downloading /Marivic Enguerra, /Jennifer Estargo/ and Krizzle Antivola/ with the help of other offices/ specially the accounting office./

- **Food Packs from LGU to all HHs (3waves) / and those lockdown houses, /nagkapira din kita naglockdown/... nagbibilang an iba san hatag san LGU,/ minsan namamali / na an hatag san LGU hale daw sa DSWD/ kay pan-o man an mga nagdidistribute MSWD/ ... domdomon ta lang po pirme / yaa an Municipio /para mag-imod san pangangaipo nato.**

- **PPEs and Vitamins: Frontliners with continues supply and Seniors (1-Month Supply of VitC), majority were purchased from our fund/ but there are also donations/ from concerned organizations and individuals / ...

- **Addressed Mental Health Issues of Youth – per clamour from the youth sector of depression, /online virtual talakayan on Mental Health /and how to survive Covid-19 /was done with our very own Dr. Joeffrey Quiring (eldest son of Dr. Joe Quiring) /and another invitee who's well versed also on the topic/ ... Thanks Sir Pat for all the initiatives on this. / I hope it did help our youngsters cope up./**

- **RTK Availability – to lessen cost of those who wanted to avail, /we also purchased our own/ in coordination with our medTechs from our Gubat District Hospital. / Salamat po.**
- **Equipment Acquisition – purchased equipment/ has also a double purpose/ like the fogging machine /which can later be used for Dengue/.**

- **Contact Tracing – LGU is so grateful for the participation of the PNP and BFP/ spearheaded by our HRHs of DOH /assigned to Gubat in almost per Barangay ratio /and later part were the hired Contact Tracers of DILG. / Sa lado na ini /gusto ko pasalamatan an saato HRHs /nan an RHU Team through Jason Buenaobra. /May incident na ma-Immunize na an saato medical team /and they have to quarantine/ in protection to the children that they will immunize, /wara pa man sadto an DILG CTs /but /our 2 hired JOs /na naging kaupod san PNP-BFP tandem san CTng nato/ ... PNP-BFP salamat sa pagiging BoyScouts, /ready at all times./**
- **Aid to Barangays for the BIUs – P3000/mo for those barangays sustaining the BIUs**

As of 12/31/2020, /we have served 5,006 PUMs:/ assessed at BUQFac /which some stayed for a few days/ to qualify for HQ /(RTK/Antigen per EO/period covered) = 3,310;/ PUM @ BIUs assessed/some stayed for a few days at QFac = 943, / and 14-day completion from day1-14 totally at QFac = 709. We also have served a total of 189 PIUs. To date/ we have maintained 0 active case status./

An pagprayoridad nato sini na laban sa Covid-19,/ grabe an naging epekto sa mga proyekto ta sa mga barangay /na halos naire-align/naireprogram pero an pinakaimportante baga an saato mga kabobongto na mailikay sa hapdos na ini. Our people is more important / than all those projects, / we can have all of those / when our people are well and healthy.

Aside from the so busy schedule for COVID-19, we never forget /the regular responsibility of the MHO/ and the Doktor sa mga Barangay /who joint force in the realization of “Mabaskog na Gubatnon” /through the Child Care Immunization, /vitamin-A Supplementation /and Deworming Program/ during the 1st semester of the year. /MR OPV SIA Activity was done again/ in October 26 to December 4, 2020 /with a total of 4,379 recipients (67.4%) for MR /and OPV of 5,016 (66.3%)./

Anti-Flu and Anti-Pneumonia were also given to some of our Senior Citizens/ for their much needed protection./

Other activities were on Nutrition Services/ from breastfeeding to complimentary feeding/ and deworming. /For this year, /we’re zero on maternal death/ but 1 case of infant death./

Maternal and Child Care Programs are vital programs in our community/ *per record / but /on the Family Planning Program of WRA, out of 16 404 target we only have 3 575 which is 22% only.*

Other Programs include/ the TB Control Program /with 145/281 patients/ and with 132/147 success rate equivalent to 89.8%./

Another program is the Management of the Lifestyle Related Diseases, /we screened DM and HPN /using PhilPEN Risk Protocol, /18y/o & above: 2 756/2 756./ Management of Hypertensive 4 185/4 185; /Diabetes Mellitus 532/532 – all 100% per target. /

Another is the Mobile Blood Donation Program:/ 100% of the target for the number of blood donors/ and repeat blood donors /of 634 and 190 respectively./

MNAO – Operation Timbang Plus /was participated by all 42 barangays /with 4,259 targeted beneficiaries /over a possible total of 7,230 = 58.9% accomplished. / Distribution of other supplements as eggs from the provincial government, /LGU's/ and GSAC's milk feeding, /food packs/ and vitamins has targeted 25 barangays /with 155/155 = 100% accomplished /in August 2020 /and a 63/63 = 100% accomplished /in November, 2020./

Our DSMB, /before the pandemic /had its usual round of check-up, /consultations, /referrals and other medical interventions/ from January to February of 2020 to wit: /OPLAN TSEKUP/ – having 2,181 patients consulted,/ 11 surgical patients referred and assisted/ and 34 bedridden patients visited; /barangay consultations reached to 2,226 patients/ and at the office consultation reached to 223 /with 28 barangays visited. /Most common illnesses were:/

- 1. Acute Respiratory Infection**
- 2. Hypertension**
- 3. Osteoarthritis**
- 4. Skin Disorders**
- 5. GERD**

With the halt of DSMB, /and the concentration to the fight against COVID-19,/ medicine dispensing w/ prescriptions /continued /together with the maintenance drugs on LSRD /and vitamins to our vulnerable./

DSMB, /a local health program /is the true picture of government coming closer to our people,/ the only thing I promised during the campaign /while all achievements were guided by the vision of “Gubat, a place of trade and industry, agro and eco-tourism and quality education through SHARED governance”.

Magkaupod an Agrikultura nan Piskariya / na mao an Hanapbuhay san kadaghanan dini saato bongto / as we are primarily classified an agricultural community / with more or less having the same palay production as Irosin, na rice granary san probinsya./ We are as well a fishing community having 13 coastal barangays/ with potential on seaweed farming /and the mangrove crab industry /which we are asking for Congress' consideration /and Intervention /with regards to FAO264/ ... this is a technical matter that requires a technical study/ on the Gubat situation./ San mga nakaagi na bulan/ nilibot nato an mga coastal barangays/ lalo na an mga crablet gatherers /para mabati mismo /an kanira agrangay /and we have 1000+ of them./ Pinaupod ta sa BFAR personnel / para sa kinundusar na pag-aadal /and I am hoping / that it will not just stop there / but / this study/ will continue to further realize our claim/ and finally come up with a win-win situation /on both the livelihood of our people/ and their participation in the care for the environment./

Quality education is very part of our vision for Gubat, / thus in spite of the pandemic / education has to continue among our children,/ among our teens / and even among our adults ...

Pre-Schoolers: our DDC-ECCD covering all barangays 1st quarter of 2020 (last quarter of SY 2019-2020) have served 1,236 children/ and from September to present we have 1,070 enrollees/ for modular education/ where modules are being printed at LGU/ for distribution to each respective DCC-ECCD teachers/ in each barangay/ where parent participation is being sought. /Other support for the success rate of education /is the Supplementary Feeding /which continues with our 1,077 children to date./**

Likewise in our public kindergarten classes / we reproduced the modules from weeks 1-6 for both GND and GSD. / Although this is a very difficult situation for our children / as for their age group / they needed sensory learning before the written one for more learnings na kaipuhanonon an physical contact with the teachers and their classmates / but this is equally difficult for the teachers and parents as well/ .. aram nato na grabe an epekto san klase san pagmanihar ta/ sa pag-edukar san saato mga kabataan/ pero an importante, /intero naghihinguha/ para matukduan an mga kabataan, /may mga nagkakaraw ngani /na dahil san partisipasyon san mga ina /... an mga ina an magkaka-honor./

4. **Other Educational Offering:/ Drivers' Education/ through LTO Outreach /which benefitted a 100 for free/ instead of P3,500 each;/ we also have the TESDA offering for Events Management /and another on Driving,/ these two was started December 2020 /and to continue the next succeeding months of 2021./ In compliance to the Traffic Ordinance /that Tricy Drivers will have Driving Review Classes /before the issuance of permits,/ an local na gobyerno /nakikoordinar sa LTO/ para mailibre ini /na talagang dako man an matitipid san kada Driver/ and to think /na we have 1500 /to 1600 drivers to date/ na maka-avail sini.**

With the big participation of the youth during this pandemic, /the LGU Gubat launched its first ever "Saludo Gubatnon" /to honor the different contributions of the Youth Organizations of the town./ Maybe by next time/ iba naman na category,/ maybe the young professionals/ or entrepreneurs or Seniors ...

D – Dedikasyon sa Pase y Orden

As the first town in the Province of Sorsogon to launch the RCSP /for the primary aim of attaining peace and order,/ we have identified 11 affected Barangays/ through the Philippine Army/ which was participated by inter-agencies' assessment /and assistance/ to realize their most awaited needs /and projects /which happened through people's participation/ solution seeking table similar to round table discussion./ To date, /the 11 Barangays/ are awaiting approval of the proposals submitted./ Along with that,/ Barangayan and Serbisyo Caravan was also done /where NGAs and LGU Offices/ are present /at their respective

barangays /and venues/ which is very similar to our local program of “PAGTIRIPON”/ which was done and implemented /prior to RCSP launching./

On the other hand,/ we have continuously monitored and managed our MADAC/ and BADACs/ where to date, /out of the 22/42 affected barangays, /we only have 9 for final clearing /but during the inaguaration of the Balay Silangan/ in Buenavista,/ we were informed/ that the 5 submitted barangay folders are already approved /thus/ we only have 4 to go./ For this 4 barangays,/ the folders are now ready for submission /and we are aiming/ for a drug-cleared municipality come 1st quarter of the year./ With the Balay Silangan inaugurated in December 30 of this year, /we can have a place for some reforms /and give 2nd chances to our brothers/ who have in a way lost track /and got involved in the illegal drugs/. We are also very lucky this year for having received the new PNP Mobile Car for our policemen.

To address the peace and order / is also to address the economic stability of a community /one project of which can also address the realization of our place / as a center of trade and industry/ is the blessing and opening of the L-Shaped Section of the New Public Market / as well as the rehabilitation of the Wet Section of the market/ and the establishment of the CCTV within the area/.

Along with attaining peace and order /we have different programs assigned to our MSWDO/ like the Family Program,/ UHC in coordination with MHO, /Women’s Welfare,/ PWD’s Welfare Program,/ *Elderly Welfare Program/ with the pandemic,/ the 80 and above/ were given a P1000 year-end financial assistance /and previous to that/ is a month supply of Vit-C to all Seniors,/ Emergency Assistance,/ Aftercare Program /and Emergency Cash Subsidy /under the Social Amelioration Program of DSWD./ We also have 2 children now placed in Casa Miani for assistance,/ protected 9 children at risk/ and 5 children in conflict with law /which we have supported. / Along with this, we have interventions on child custody and child support (8),/ case management for legal guardianship (3children)/ and case management for adoption (1),/and special protection of children against all forms of abuse (4 sexual and 2 physical)/.*

With the discussed programs of SHARED Governance, may I present to you the projects to support our vision: “Gubat, a place of trade and industry, agro & eco tourism and quality education”.
