RESOLUTION NO. 195 S-2019

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING TO THE DIVISION SUPERINTENDENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepED), SORSOGON DIVISION OFFICE, SORSOGON CITY, THE INCLUSION OF POTTERY MAKING/INDUSTRY IN THE SELECTED STRANDS/TRACK OR CURRICULUM OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF GUBAT, SORSOGON.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Gubat, Sorsogon particularly the barangay of Paradijon was locally known in the past to have engaged in the pottery making/industry and most of the residents derived their income on this livelihood and occupation;

WHEREAS, for no apparent reasons and changes of time, said pottery making activities in the said barangay lost its track and seems to have forgotten by the residents particularly the new generation;

WHEREAS, it is an ardent hope of the Local Government Unit of Gubat to revert back this common ways and tradition of pottery making not only in the Barangay of Paradijon but the rest of the barangays of the municipality;

WHEREAS, this local government unit is persistent enough to introduce back the industry with a hope of significant innovation on styles and face value of the products, thus, creating more demands for market;

WHEREAS, the only positive way of introducing back the pottery making /industry in this municipality is for this local government unit to work in partnership with the schools and learning institutions where student's interest and skills can be reached out;

WHEREAS, consistent with the R. A. 10533, "Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013", that includes Senior High School in the K-12 basic education reform program, the Department of Education is mandated by the said law to formulate the design and details of the enhanced basic education which includes curriculum development "*that allows school to localize, indigenize and enhance the same based on the their respective educational and social contexts. The production and development of locally produced teaching materials shall be encouraged and approval of these materials shall devolve to the regional and division units*";

WHEREAS, above provisions of the law gives precedent to this local government unit to allow the integration of the locally known pottery making in the curriculum of all Senior High Schools in the Municipality of Gubat, Sorsogon;


NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Danilo J. Pura and unanimously seconded, it was;
