RESOLUTION NO. 263 S-2019

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF COMMUNITY - DRIVEN DEVELOPMENT (CDD) AS A NATIONAL STRATEGY AND AN APPROACH FOR LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION.

WHEREAS, KALAHI CIDSS-NCDDP, otherwise known as Kapit-Bisig Laban sa Kahirapan, Comprehensive Delivery of Social Services - National Community Driven Development Program (KC-NCDDP for brevity) is one of the poverty alleviation programs of the Philippine government being implemented by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD);

WHEREAS, in search of better approaches in implementation the DSWD started trying out Community-Driven Development (CDD) approach in 2002, building on its experience in community - based participatory development thereby making people at the center of decision-making processes;

WHEREAS, CDD was introduced for improved outcomes in service delivery, local governance and community empowerment which specifically 1.) empowers communities by treating them not as passive recipients of assistance and services but as partners towards development, 2) improves local governance by improving people's engagement, making the process more democratic and participatory and 3) reduces poverty by implementing barangay- level projects that respond to the communities felt needs and problems;

WHEREAS, CDD is a globally recognized strategy for achieving service delivery, poverty reduction and good governance outcomes where local communities take control in planning, implementing and resource investments;

WHEREAS, CDD ensures that development programs integrate the principles of local empowerment, participatory governance, demand - responsiveness, administrative autonomy, greater downward accountability and enhanced local capacity;

WHEREAS, CDD is in conformance with the overall framework of Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 on building a future where every Filipino enjoys a Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag na Buhay, particularly in ensuring a people- centered, clean and efficient governance;

WHEREAS, the municipality recognizes that the employment of CDD approach by KC-NCDDP is founded not on the number of structures it is able to provide the communities but on the number of people transformed to become more pro-active, empowered, and resourceful members of the society, taking part in local development;


WHEREAS, out of the 4,207 target households from 31 barangays, 4,209 households benefit from the sub-projects implemented or being implemented by KC-NCDDP as of date;

WHEREAS, as of August 2019, the Program Information Management System (PIMS) of KC- NCDDP shows that 36% of community volunteers per barangay have been trained in CDD and 80% of the total households were represented during the barangay assemblies where the marginalized can voice out their concerns, 57% of which are women, 76% are Pantawid Familyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, the Grievance Redress System (GRS) of KC- NCDDP is anchored on the basic principles of Participation, Transparency, Accountability and Community Empowerment which are all reflective of CDD;

WHEREAS, the August 2019 data form PIMS reveals that 100 % of registered grievances in the municipality are satisfactory resolved in conformance with the Grievance Redress System which is a manifestation of people's involvement in raising and addressing complaints, problems and issues arising out from program implementation;

WHEREAS, the implementation of Community Driven Development (CDD) Programs in different barangays of this municipality, help intensify the local empowerment and participation of the grassroots, which enable this local government unit to set its proper direction of local governance;




NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Alvin E. Rosales, duly seconded by Honorable Kenneth D. Escandor, it was;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to support the institutionalization of Community - Driven Development (CDD) as a national strategy and an approach for local development planning and implementation;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the Barangay Local Government Units, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) and such other agencies or organizations which may take concrete measures towards the institutionalization of CDD as a national strategy and an approach for local development planning and implementation.
