EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020- II

AN ORDER REGULATING THE FLOW OF VEHICLES INSIDE THE  
PAMANA TERMINAL FOR ITS EFFICIENT AND ORDERLY  
OPERATION AND IMPOSING THE FEES UNDER EXISTING TAX  
ORDINANCE FOR THE USE THEREOF

WHEREAS, PAMANA Terminal is the current designated parking area of all PUBLIC UTILITY JEEPNEYS (PUJs) plying the different routes to the neighboring towns and barangays of Gubat, Sorsogon and vice-versa.

WHEREAS, currently no parking fees are being charged from the PUJ organizations/association/cooperative utilizing the said terminal;

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the number of vehicles that are using the PAMANA Terminal as their holding area while awaiting their turn in queuing in their assigned lane to load passengers so that congestion and/or accident can be avoided.

NOW THEREFORE, I, SHARON ROSE G. ESCOTO, Municipal Mayor of Gubat, Sorsogon by virtue of the power vested in my by law, do hereby order the following:

**Section I. Rules and Regulations:**

1. That there would an individual designated queuing lane for every PUJ Organization/Association/Cooperative using the PAMANA Terminal.

2. That queuing and parking arrangement of jeepney associations/organization/cooperative shall be in accordance with the sketch plan prepared by the local government unit hereto attached as **Annex A** and is made an integral part of this Order.

3. That every PUJ association/organization/cooperative shall be allowed to utilize the PAMANA Terminal as their holding area provided that the same shall be limited to FIVE (5) UNITS AT A TIME in addition to the PUJ already in the queuing lane.

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4. That the respective jeepney organization/association/cooperative using the PAMANA Terminal shall pay the parking fees stated under ARTICLE O of Tax Ordinance No. 2004 -002 otherwise known as the 2005 REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GUBAT, PROVINCE OF SORSOGON, the specific provision of which is hereto attached as **Annex B** and is likewise made an integral part of this Order.

5. That the local government unit through the Public Order and Safety Officers with the assistance of the assigned personnel from the Gubat Municipal Police Station shall oversee the queuing procedure at the PAMANA Terminal for order, safety and efficiency.

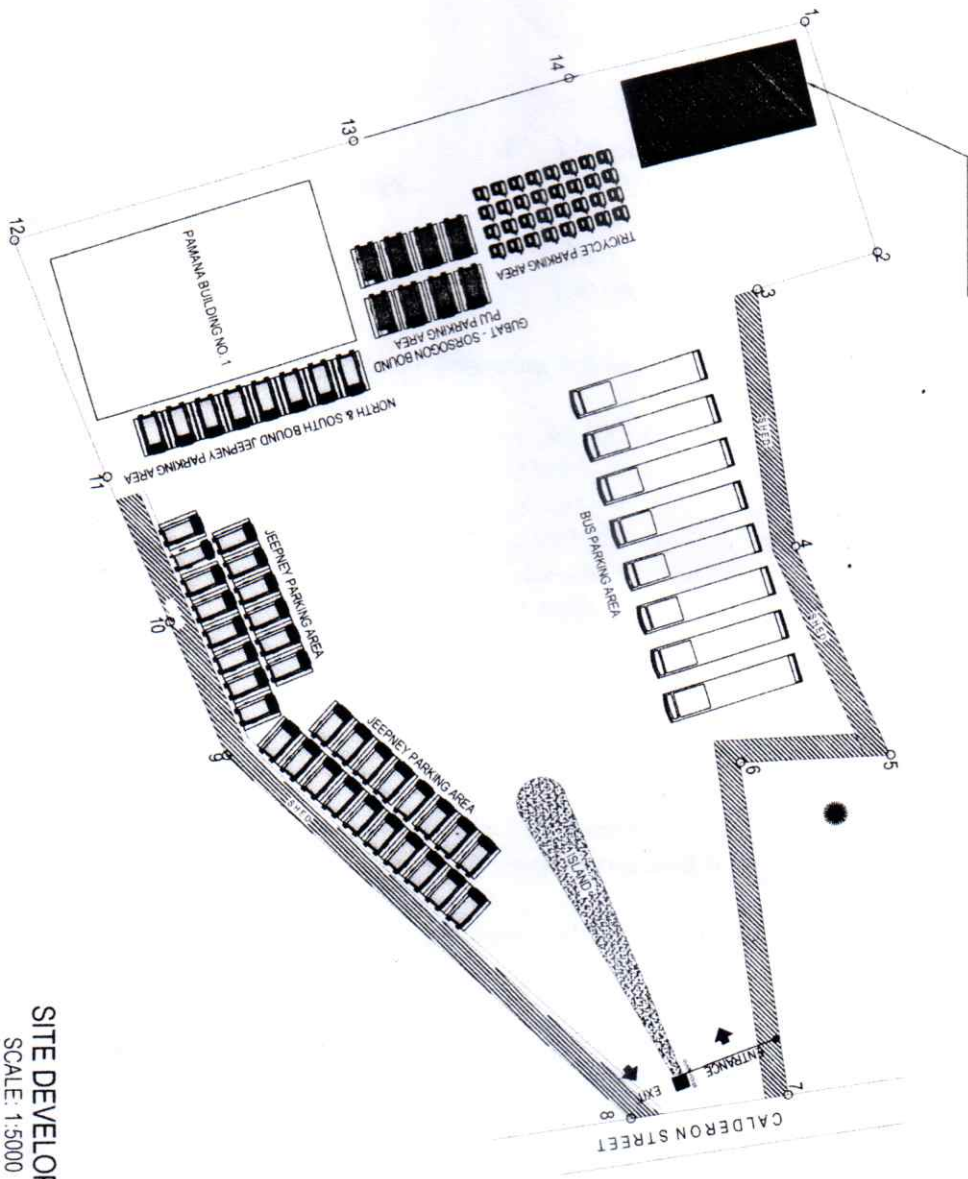

That the local government unit as the owner of the PAMANA Terminal reserves the right to expel and prohibit any jeepney association/group/cooperative and/or operator or driver from using the PAMANA Terminal for willfull violation of any of the provisions of this Order or who will prevent, threaten, harass or coerce any PUJ association/organization/cooperative and/or jeepney operator or driver from utilizing its/his assigned lane at the PAMANA Terminal without any valid or legal justification

**Section II. Effectivity.** This order shall take effect immediately.

**TAX ORDINANCE NO. 2004 -002**

**2005 REVENUE CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GUBAT,  
PROVINCE OF SORSOGON**

**Article O. Charges of Parking**

Section 1. Imposition of Fee. There shall be collected fees for the use of municipal owned parking area or designated streets for pay parking in accordance with the following schedule:

a. Day Parking Rates

Vehicle Type	P
Tricycle -	3.00 per unit/day
Privates cars and Service Vehicles -	10.00/unit/hour
Cargo Trucks, 10W -	75.00
Trucks, 6 W -	50.00
Passenger Bus -	100.00

Passenger Jeepneys, in accordance with the following schedule:

Route	Parking Fee per Month
Bulusan	P1,000.00
Prieto Diaz	1,500.00
Sorsogon City	3,000.00
Bentuco-Togawe-Tigkiw	600.00
Barcelona	800.00
Nato, Patag, Judi	Adult Fare x 20days

b. Overnight Parking Rates

All types of vehicles, per 24 hours - P 10.00

c. A towing fee of P300.00 and impounding fee of P100.00/day shall be collected from owners of vehicles who violated this provision before the vehicle is released to the owner.

Section 2. Time of Payment. The fess herein imposed for all vehicles except tricycles, shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer or to his duly delegated representative upon parking thereat. The Municipal Treasurer is hereby authorized to collect from the tricycle drivers/operators the parking fees due a period upon application of the annual supervision fee.

Section 3. Computation for Parking Fee

a) It is assumed that the tricycle has been operated for at least 20 days in one month the number of days of which were consumed for repairs, registration and other personal use have been deducted.

b) 20 days multiplied by P3.00 equals P60.00

c) This means that the amount payable for parking fee for a given MONTH is P60.00.

d) In case the tricycle requires longer days for repairs and the driver or owner opts to suspend the tricycle for public transport use, he is required to surrender the plate number issued for the current year to the licensing division in the Office of the Mayor as proof. In the assessment of the total parking fees due, the number of days that the tricycle has been withdrawn from public use shall not be included in the computation.

e) Tricycle operator's or drivers have the option to pay the parking fees herein mentioned whether monthly, quarterly or annually. It is their duty to inform the officer in charge of fee collection.

f) Association of jeepney drivers and operators in the corresponding routes shall be responsible for the payment of the monthly parking fee herein prescribed.
