EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020 - 029

STAGGERING THE ARRIVAL AND ACCEPTANCE OF LOCALLY STRANDED INDIVIDUALS (LSIs) AND OTHER RETURNING RESIDENTS TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF GUBAT, SORSOGON

Whereas, there are confirmed Covid-19 cases within the municipality of Gubat;

Whereas, the health and safety of everyone is of primary concern hence the spread of the disease must be prevented;

Whereas, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-087 delegated the responsibilities in the management of LSIs and returning overseas Filipinos to local government units;

Whereas, Executive Order No. 51-2020 issued last 4 August 2020 further provided for rules in the implementation of mandatory quarantine in the Province of Sorsogon;

Whereas, the Quarantine Facility (QF) and Barangay Isolation Units (BIUs) in the municipality of Gubat have been experiencing full capacity;

Whereas, to better prepare the QF and BIUs and optimize the health care services for the LSIs and returning residents;

Now therefore, I, Sharon Rose G. Escoto, Municipal Mayor of Gubat, Sorsogon by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Mandatory Quarantine. All persons entering the municipality shall undergo a mandatory 14-day quarantine, except those with a Letter of Exemption (LOE) signed by the provincial governor.

Section 2. Limit in the number of LSIs and returning residents to be accepted and accommodated at the QF and BIUs. The municipality shall accept the maximum of fifty-five (55) LSIs and returning residents at the Bicol University QF and a total of 248 at the BIUs per batch subject to the maximum carrying capacity per BIU (see Table 1 Number of Capacity per BIU).

Section 3. Staggered arrival schedule. The QF and BIUs shall only accept LSIs and returning residents every 16th to the 31st of the month. No LSIs or returning residents shall be accommodated from the 1st to the 15th of the month starting November 2020 until further notice.

Section 4. Requirements. All LSIs and returning residents shall submit the following requirements:

- a. Travel authority from point of origin;
- b. Letter of acceptance from the municipality or the barangay where one intends to quarantine; and
- c. Medical Certificate issued by the Authorized Government Health Facility (issued within 7 days before arrival in the municipality).
- d. Negative Covid-19 swab or rapid test result if available (issued within 7 days before arrival in the municipality).

Section 5. Pre-registration. LSIs and returning residents are encouraged to fill-out a pre-registration form through any of the following:

- a. Online via: tinyurl.com/GubatLSI
- b. Phone call: 0963-6742791
- c. Manual registration through a proxy/ representative at the Mayor's Office or the BUQF.

Registrants will be sent a confirmation email/ text/ call and further instructions on how to submit/ upload required documents.

Section 6. Monitoring and Enforcement. The Rural Health Unit (RHU), Philippine National Police (PNP), barangay officials, and the Gubat Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) are responsible for the enforcement and monitoring of the implementation of this Order.

Section 7. Repealing Cause. Any Executive Orders previously issued that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order is considered repealed, amended, and modified accordingly.

Section 8. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless otherwise amended, repealed, or modified.
