

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2021-03

STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MANAGEMENT, CONTAINMENT AND CONTROL OF AFRICAN SWINE FEVER (ASF) INCLUDING THE ZONING AND MOVEMENT PROTOCOLS ON THE MOVEMENT, SALE AND TRADE OF HOGS AND PORK PRODUCTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF GUBAT, SORSOGON

WHEREAS, the prevalence of COVID-19 is a continuing threat to each and every one;

WHEREAS, African Swine Fever (ASF) also poses a clear and present danger to the local piggery industry;

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide preventive measures to lessen the risk of contamination of the said illnesses which affect people and animals respectively;

WHEREAS, Department of Agriculture Administrative Order No. 10 S. 2019 provides the guidelines in the movement of live animals from swine farms within the 1 KM zone of ASF;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Sharon Rose G. Escoto, Municipal Mayor of Gubat, Sorsogon by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Creation of Municipal African Swine Fever Task Force – A Municipal African Swine Fever Task Force (MASF-TF) is hereby created to monitor and implement the guidelines and protocols against ASF as defined in this Order. The Task Force shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Preventive Measures against ASF. The following preventive measures against ASF shall be observed:

- A. There shall be a temporary banning of all incoming and outgoing swine to and from Gubat for three (3) months which may be extended if the ASF situation so warrants.
- **B.** There shall be a temporary banning of movement of all swine (piglets, breeders and fatteners) within the buffer zones for three (3) months which may be extended if the ASF situation so warrants.
- C. Transport of live swine, and raw pork products coming from outside of Gubat shall be temporarily banned. Processed pork products (cooked or uncooked) may be allowed provided that necessary documents required by the Department of Agriculture-Bureau of Animal Industry (DA-BAI), National Meat Inspection Service (NMIS), and Food and Drug Administration (FDA) are complied with, to include but not limited to:
 - 1. Certificate of product registration issued by the Food and Drug Authority
 - 2. NMIS Delivery Van Accreditation authorizing its movement for distribution
 - 3. NMIS Certification for Locally Sourced Pork (for processed meat products such as tocino, longganisa, and tapa)
 - Veterinary Health Certificate of exporting country and Sanitary and Phyto Sanitary Import Permit issued by the DA
- D. All owners/traders of live swine for slaughtering from anyplace within Gubat shall secure Certificate of Origin from respective barangay and Animal Inspection Certificate from the Authorized Inspector from the Municipal Agriculture Office, weekdays from 8:00AM to 4:00PM. Said certifications shall be presented to the Meat Inspector prior to slaughtering of swine.

Section 2. Duty of the Punong Barangay. All Punong Barangay are hereby directed to issue certificate of origin to all outgoing swine from respective barangays based on the zoning status. Further, all Punong Barangay are required to organize

an ASF Monitoring Task Force to enforce the measures defined in this Order at the barangay level.

Section 3. Observance of health protocols - All health protocols issued by duly constituted authorities relative to the prevention of the spread of COVID-19 disease and the African Swine Fever shall be strictly implemented and observed.

Section 4. Monitoring and Enforcement. The Municipal Agriculture Office, the Mayor's Office, Gubat MPS, Meat Inspector together with the ASF Contact Tracing team shall be responsible for the monitoring and enforcement of the implementation of this order.

Section 5. Incorporation Clause. All laws, legal orders, rules and regulations that have been issued and/or will be issued by the duly constituted authorities of the Republic of the Philippines in relation to COVID-19 and the African Swine Fever are hereby incorporated herein and made an integral part hereof. In case of conflict, such laws, legal orders, rules and regulations shall have precedence over the provisions of this Executive Order.

Section 5. Repealing Clause-Any Executive Orders previously issued that are inconsistent to the provisions of this Executive Order is considered repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

Section 6. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any provision of this Order is declared unconstitutional or contrary to law, the other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 7. Effectivity- This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain valid and effective unless otherwise amended, repealed or modified accordingly.
