



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 7**  
**Series of 2022**

**RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER  
COUNCIL (MPOC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GUBAT**

**WHEREAS**, Section 116 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the establishment in every province, city and municipality of a local peace and order council pursuant to Executive Order No. 309, s. 1988;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 773, s. 2009, further reorganized the peace and order council on the national, regional, and municipal levels of government;

**WHEREAS**, Section 444 (b) (2) (iii) of the said Code provides that the local chief executive shall “[i]ssue such executive orders as are necessary for the proper enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances”;

**NOW THEREFORE, I RONNEL U. LIM**, Municipal Mayor of Gubat, Province of Sorsogon, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**Section 1. Composition.** The Municipal Peace and Order Council is hereby reconstituted to be composed of the following:

**Section 2. Duties and Functions.** The Council shall have the following duties and functions:

- (a) Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberation of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including insurgency;
- (b) Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety in their respective areas of responsibility, including anti-insurgency measures;
- (c) Recommend measures to converge and orchestrate internal security operations efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;

- (d) Apply moral suasion to and/or recommend sanctions against local chief executives who are giving material and political support to the Communist rebels;
- (e) Monitor the provision of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in the remote rural and indigenous population areas adopted to isolate them from the Communist rebels' "Agitate/Arouse, Organize and Mobilize" and ideological, political and organization works;
- (f) Perform all other functions assigned by law, the President or the NPOC.

**Section 3. Secretariat.** The Secretariat shall be headed by the DILG officer assigned in the Municipality and shall be assisted in its functions and duties by the staff of the Mayor. The Secretariat shall be responsible for providing technical support, documentation of proceedings, preparation of reports and other assistance as may be required in the discharge of its functions.

**Section 4. Automatic Succession of Members.** In case of resignation, retirement, separation, transfer, reassignment, removal of a member, the successor or replacement shall automatically take the position and serve only for the unexpired term. Provided that in case of leave or suspension, the replacement shall serve only for the duration of the leave or suspension.

**Section 5. Repealing Clause.** Any Administrative or Executive Order previously issued that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order shall be considered repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**Section 6. Separability Clause.** In the event that any provision of this Executive Order is held invalid or unconstitutional, the provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 7. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
